## A BILL

To amend section 1505 of the Higher Education Act of 1965 to provide for the continuity of the Board of Trustees of the Institute of American Indian and Alaska Native Culture and Arts Development.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CONTINUITY OF BOARD.**

4 Section 1505(i) of the Higher Education Amend-  
5 ments of 1986 (20 U.S.C. 4412(i)) is amended—

6 (1) in paragraph (1), by inserting before the pe-  
7 riod at the end of the first sentence the following:

1 “or to recommend another individual if the member  
2 does not consent to be reappointed”; and

3 (2) by striking paragraph (2) and inserting the  
4 following:

5 “(2) If the President has not transmitted to the  
6 Senate a nomination to fill the position of a member  
7 covered by such a recommendation within 60 days  
8 from the date that the member’s term expires—

9 “(A) if the member consents to reappoint-  
10 ment, the member shall be deemed to have been  
11 reappointed for another full term to the Board,  
12 with all the appropriate rights and responsibil-  
13 ities; or

14 “(B) if the member does not consent to re-  
15 appointment, an individual recommended by the  
16 Board under paragraph (1) shall be deemed to  
17 have been appointed for a full term to the  
18 Board with all the appropriate rights and re-  
19 sponsibilities.”.
