A BILL

To prohibit providers of cellular and other mobile radio services from blocking access to 911 emergency services.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. UNBLOCKING REQUIRED.**

4 Section 332(c) of the Communications Act of 1934
5 (47 U.S.C. 332(c)) is amended by adding at the end there-
6 of the following:

7 “(9) EMERGENCY SERVICES UNBLOCKING.—

8 The Commission shall, by regulation, prohibit pro-
9 viders of commercial mobile services from blocking

1 access to emergency 911 services, as necessary in
2 the public interest.”.
