1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. FEDERAL EMPLOYEES CONTRACTING OR**
2 **TRADING WITH INDIANS.**

3 (a) **REPEAL.**—Section 437 of title 18, United States
4 Code, is repealed.

5 (b) **CONFORMING AMENDMENT.**—The table of sec-
6 tions at the beginning of chapter 23 of title 18, United
7 States Code, is amended by striking the item relating to
8 section 437.

9 (c) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The repeal made by sub-
10 section (a) shall—

11 (1) take effect on the date of enactment of this
12 Act; and

13 (2) apply with respect to any contract obtained,
14 and any purchase or sale occurring, on or after the
15 date of enactment of this Act.
