A BILL

To authorize immediate haying and grazing during 1996 on certain lands enrolled in the conservation reserve program in the State of Tennessee.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EMERGENCY HAYING AND GRAZING ON CER-**
4 **TAIN CONSERVATION RESERVE PROGRAM**
5 **ACREAGE IN TENNESSEE.**

6 (a) HAYING AND GRAZING AUTHORIZED.—Notwith-
7 standing section 1232(a)(7) of the Food Security Act of
8 1985 (16 U.S.C. 3832(a)(7)), the owner or operator of

1 a farm or ranch located in the State of Tennessee may
2 hay and graze land that—

3 (1) is part of that farm or ranch;

4 (2) is enrolled in the conservation reserve estab-
5 lished under subchapter B of chapter 1 of subtitle
6 D of title XII of such Act (16 U.S.C. 3831 et seq.);
7 and

8 (3) is designated as conservation practice 1
9 land.

10 (b) EFFECTIVE PERIOD.—Subsection (a) shall be ef-
11 fective during the period beginning on the date of the en-
12 actment of this Act and ending on September 30, 1996.
