A BILL

To amend the Public Health Service Act to provide for research to determine the extent to which the presence of dioxin in tampons poses any health risks to women.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Women’s Health and
5 Dioxin Act of 1996”.

1 **SEC. 2. OFFICE OF RESEARCH ON WOMEN'S HEALTH; ES-**
2 **TABLISHMENT OF PROGRAM FOR RESEARCH**
3 **REGARDING PRESENCE OF DIOXIN IN TAM-**
4 **PONS.**

5 Part F of title IV of the Public Health Service Act
6 (42 U.S.C. 287d et seq.) is amended by adding at the end
7 the following section:

8 **"SEC. 486C. CERTAIN PROJECTS REGARDING WOMEN'S**
9 **HEALTH.**

10 "The Director of NIH, in collaboration with the Di-
11 rector of the Office, shall provide for the conduct or sup-
12 port of research to determine the extent to which the pres-
13 ence of dioxin in tampons poses any health risks to
14 women, including risks relating to cervical cancer."
