3 **SECTION 1. HONORABLE DAVID H. PRYOR POST OFFICE**
4 **BUILDING.**

5 (a) DESIGNATION.—The United States Post Office
6 building located at 351 Washington Street in Camden, Ar-
7 kansas, is designated as the “Honorable David H. Pryor
8 Post Office Building”.

1 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in any law, map,
2 regulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
3 States to the United States Post Office building referred
4 to in section 1 is deemed to be a reference to the “Honor-
5 able David H. Pryor Post Office Building”.
