## A BILL

For the relief of David R. W. Light.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. AUTHORIZATION TO REMAIN TEMPORARILY IN**  
4 **THE UNITED STATES FOR DAVID R. W. LIGHT.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Attorney General—

6 (1) shall refrain from deporting David R. W.  
7 Light from the United States and permit him to re-  
8 main temporarily in the United States notwithstand-  
9 ing section 241(a) of the Immigration and National-  
10 ity Act; and

11 (2) shall authorize David R. W. Light to engage  
12 in employment in the United States and provide him

1 with an “employment authorized” endorsement or  
2 other appropriate work permit.

3 (b) GROUNDS FOR DEPORTATION.—The stay of de-  
4 portation under subsection (a) shall apply only to grounds  
5 for deportation that are based on the expiration of the  
6 most recent nonimmigrant visa issued to David R. W.  
7 Light under section 101(a)(15)(J) of the Immigration and  
8 Nationality Act.

9 (c) DURATION OF STAY OF DEPORTATION AND  
10 WORK AUTHORIZATION.—The stay of deportation and  
11 work authorization under subsection (a) shall be effective  
12 during the 3-year period beginning on the date of the en-  
13 actment of this Act.
