Mr. ROTH introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

To require approval of an application for compensation for the injuries of Eugene Hasenfus.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. APPROVAL OF APPLICATION.**

4 Eugene Hasenfus, who was injured on October 5,
5 1986, shall be deemed to have been an employee of the
6 United States Government in the performance of his du-
7 ties at the time of his injury for the purpose of determin-
8 ing eligibility for compensation for his injuries under sec-
9 tion 8102 of title 5, United States Code, and the applica-

1 tion for such compensation shall be deemed filed in a time-
2 ly manner on his behalf. Such application shall be ap-
3 proved, and payments shall be made thereon as computed
4 by the Secretary of Labor pursuant to the provisions of
5 section 8101 et seq. of title 5, United States Code.

6 **SEC. 2. LIMITATION ON COMPENSATION.**

7 A claim or award for compensation for legal or other
8 services rendered in connection with obtaining relief au-
9 thorized by section 1 shall be valid only if approved by
10 the Secretary of Labor, any contract to the contrary not-
11 withstanding.
