A BILL

To authorize the Secretary of the Interior to acquire certain interests in the Waihee Marsh and along the Waihee Stream for inclusion in the Oahu National Wildlife Refuge Complex.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION. 1. AUTHORITY TO ACQUIRE INTERESTS FOR IN-**
4 **CLUSION IN THE OAHU NATIONAL WILDLIFE**
5 **REFUGE COMPLEX.**

6 (a) AUTHORITY TO ACQUIRE.—The Secretary of the
7 Interior may acquire the following for inclusion in the
8 Oahu National Wildlife Refuge Complex:

1 (1) The area known as the Waihee Marsh, lo-
2 cated on the northeast coast of the Island of Oahu,
3 Hawaii, consisting of approximately 30 acres (as de-
4 termined by the Secretary) along both sides of Ka-
5 mehameha Highway.

6 (2) A conservation easement in lands that are
7 within approximately 100 feet of either bank of the
8 Waihee Stream, which is located adjacent to the
9 Waihee Marsh referred to in paragraph (1).

10 (b) MANAGEMENT OF ACQUIRED INTERESTS.—
11 Lands and interests acquired by the United States under
12 this section shall be managed by the Secretary of the Inte-
13 rior as part of the Oahu National Wildlife Refuge Com-
14 plex.
