To amend the independent counsel provisions of title 28, United States Code, to authorize the appointment of an independent counsel when the Attorney General determines that Department of Justice attorneys have engaged in certain conduct.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ADDITIONAL AUTHORITY FOR APPOINTMENT**
4 **OF INDEPENDENT COUNSEL.**

5 Section 592(c) of title 28, United States Code, is
6 amended by striking “or” at the end of subparagraph (A),
7 by striking the period at the end of subparagraph (B) and

1 inserting “; or”, and by adding after subparagraph (B)
2 the following:

3 “(C) the Attorney General, upon completion of
4 a preliminary examination under this chapter, deter-
5 mines that there are reasonable grounds to believe
6 that—

7 “(i) attorneys of the Department of Jus-
8 tice have engaged in prosecutorial misconduct,
9 corruption, or fraud, and

10 “(ii) further investigation is warranted.”.
