A BILL

To require the withdrawal of the United States from the North American Free Trade Agreement, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “NAFTA Withdrawal
5 Act of 1995”.

6 **SEC. 2. WITHDRAWAL FROM NAFTA.**

7 Pursuant to Article 2205 of the North American Free
8 Trade Agreement, the President of the United States

1 shall, not later than ninety days after the date of the en-
2 actment of this Act, notify the Government of Canada and
3 the Government of the United Mexican States of the with-
4 drawal of the Government of the United States from that
5 Agreement.

6 **SEC. 3. MODIFICATIONS TO UNITED STATES LAW.**

7 The President shall, not later than ninety days after
8 the date of the enactment of this Act, submit to the Con-
9 gress proposed legislation making those changes to United
10 States law that are necessary to make effective the with-
11 drawal of the United States from the North American
12 Free Trade Agreement.

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
