A BILL

To direct the Secretary of the Interior to convey to the State of Minnesota the New London National Fish Hatchery production facility.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. CONVEYANCE OF NEW LONDON NATIONAL**
2 **FISH HATCHERY PRODUCTION FACILITY.**

3 (a) CONVEYANCE AUTHORIZED.—Notwithstanding
4 any other provision of law and within 180 days after the
5 date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of the
6 Interior shall convey to the State of Minnesota without
7 reimbursement all right, title, and interest of the United
8 States in and to the property comprising the New London
9 National Fish Hatchery production facility, located out-
10 side of downtown New London, Minnesota, including—

11 (1) all easements and water rights relating to
12 that property, and

13 (2) all land, improvements, and related personal
14 property comprising that production facility.

15 (b) USE OF PROPERTY.—All property and interests
16 conveyed under this section shall be used by the Minnesota
17 Department of Natural Resources for the Minnesota fish-
18 ery resources management program.

19 ~~(c) REVERSIONARY INTEREST.—All right, title, and~~
20 ~~interest in and to all property and interests conveyed~~
21 ~~under this section shall revert to the United States on any~~
22 ~~date on which any of the property or interests are used~~
23 ~~other than for the Minnesota fishery resources manage-~~
24 ~~ment program.~~

25 (c) *USE AND REVERSIONARY INTEREST.—The prop-*
26 *erty conveyed to the State of Minnesota pursuant to this*

1 *section shall be used by the State for purposes of fishery*
2 *resources management, and if it is used for any other pur-*
3 *pose all right, title, and interest in and to all property con-*
4 *veyed pursuant to this section shall revert to the United*
5 *States. The State of Minnesota shall ensure that the prop-*
6 *erty reverting to the United States is in substantially the*
7 *same or better condition as at the time of transfer.*
