A BILL

To abolish the National Board for the Promotion of Rifle Practice and to eliminate the promotion of civilian marksmanship by the Department of Defense.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ABOLISHMENT OF BOARD.**

4 The National Board for the Promotion of Rifle Prac-
5 tice is abolished.

1 **SEC. 2. ELIMINATION OF PROMOTION OF CIVILIAN MARKS-**
2 **MANSHIP.**

3 Sections 4307, 4308, 4309, 4310, 4311, 4312, and
4 4313 of title 10, United States Code, are repealed.

5 **SEC. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

6 This Act, and the amendments made by this Act,
7 shall take effect 90 days after the date of the enactment
8 of this Act.
