## A BILL

To amend the Central Bering Sea Fisheries Enforcement Act of 1992 to prohibit fishing in the Central Sea of Okhotsk by vessels and nationals of the United States.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Sea of Okhotsk Fish-  
5 eries Enforcement Act of 1995”.

1 **SEC. 2. FISHING PROHIBITION.**

2 The Central Bering Sea Fisheries Enforcement Act  
3 of 1992 (16 U.S.C. 1823 note) is amended—

4 (1) in section 302, by inserting “and the  
5 Central Sea of Okhotsk” after “Central Bering  
6 Sea”; and

7 (2) in section 306—

8 (A) by redesignating paragraphs (2), (3),  
9 (4), (5), and (6) in order as paragraphs (3),  
10 (4), (5), (6), and (7); and

11 (B) by inserting after paragraph (1) the  
12 following:

13 “(2) CENTRAL SEA OF OKHOTSK.—The term  
14 ‘Central Sea of Okhotsk’ means the central Sea of  
15 Okhotsk area which is more than two hundred nau-  
16 tical miles seaward of the baseline from which the  
17 breadth of the territorial sea of the Russian Federa-  
18 tion is measured.”.
