## A BILL

To terminate the Office of the Surgeon General of the Public  
Health Service.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Office of Surgeon Gen-  
5 eral Termination Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. TERMINATION OF OFFICE OF SURGEON GENERAL**  
7 **OF PUBLIC HEALTH SERVICE.**

8 With respect to the Office of the Surgeon General  
9 of the Public Health Service—

1           (1) all authorities and personnel of the Office  
2           are transferred to the Assistant Secretary for Health  
3           of the Department of Health and Human Services;

4           (2) all unobligated portions of budget authority  
5           allocated for the Office are rescinded; and

6           (3) the Office, and the position of such Surgeon  
7           General, are terminated.
