Mr. LINDER, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for further consideration of the bill (H.R. 956) to establish legal standards and procedures for product liability litigation, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of
3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for further
5 consideration of the bill (H.R. 956) to establish legal
6 standards and procedures for product liability litigation,
7 and for other purposes. No further general debate shall

1 be in order. The bill shall be considered for amendment
2 under the five-minute rule. In lieu of the amendment rec-
3 ommended by the Committee on the Judiciary, it shall be
4 in order to consider as an original bill for the purpose of
5 amendment under the five-minute rule an amendment in
6 the nature of a substitute consisting of the text of H.R.
7 1075. That amendment in the nature of a substitute shall
8 be considered as read. No amendment to that amendment
9 in the nature of a substitute shall be in order except those
10 specified in the report of the Committee on Rules accom-
11 panying this resolution. Each amendment may be offered
12 only in the order specified in the report, may be offered
13 only by a Member designated in the report, shall be con-
14 sidered as read, shall be debatable for the time specified
15 in the report equally divided and controlled by the pro-
16 ponent and an opponent, shall not be subject to amend-
17 ment, and shall not be subject to a demand for division
18 of the question in the House or in the Committee of the
19 Whole. At the conclusion of consideration of the bill for
20 amendment the Committee shall rise and report the bill
21 to the House with such amendments as may have been
22 adopted. Any Member may demand a separate vote in the
23 House on any amendment adopted in the Committee of
24 the Whole to the bill or to the amendment in the nature
25 of a substitute made in order as original text. The previous

1 question shall be considered as ordered on the bill and
2 amendments thereto to final passage without intervening
3 motion except one motion to recommit with or without in-
4 structions.
