Mr. QUILLEN, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for the consideration of the bill (H.R. 655) to authorize the hydrogen research, development, and demonstration programs of the Department of Energy, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of
3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 655) to authorize the hydrogen re-
6 search, development, and demonstration programs of the

1 Department of Energy, and for other purposes. The first
2 reading of the bill shall be dispensed with. General debate
3 shall be confined to the bill and shall not exceed one hour
4 equally divided and controlled by the chairman and rank-
5 ing minority member of the Committee on Science. After
6 general debate the bill shall be considered for amendment
7 under the five-minute rule. It shall be in order to consider
8 as an original bill for the purpose of amendment under
9 the five-minute rule the amendment in the nature of a sub-
10 stitute recommended by the Committee on Science now
11 printed in the bill. Each section of the committee amend-
12 ment in the nature of a substitute shall be considered as
13 read. At the conclusion of consideration of the bill for
14 amendment the Committee shall rise and report the bill
15 to the House with such amendments as may have been
16 adopted. Any Member may demand a separate vote in the
17 House on any amendment adopted in the Committee of
18 the Whole to the bill or to the committee amendment in
19 the nature of a substitute. The previous question shall be
20 considered as ordered on the bill and amendments thereto
21 to final passage without intervening motion except one
22 motion to recommit with or without instructions.
