18 ly of amendments so printed before May 25, 1995,  
19 in the portion of the Congressional Record des-  
20 ignated for that purpose in clause 6 of rule XXIII  
21 or germane modifications of any such amendment;

23 (4) one amendment offered by the chairman of  
24 the Committee on International Relations after con-
