Mr. SOLOMON, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

---

## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2127) making appropriations for the Departments of Labor, Health and Human Services, and Education, and related agencies, for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1996, and for other purposes.

1       *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this  
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of  
3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee  
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-  
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 2127) making appropriations for

1 the Departments of Labor, Health and Human Services,  
2 and Education, and related agencies, for the fiscal year  
3 ending September 30, 1996, and for other purposes. The  
4 first reading of the bill shall be dispensed with. General  
5 debate shall be confined to the bill and shall not exceed  
6 one hour equally divided and controlled by the chairman  
7 and ranking minority member of the Committee on Appro-  
8 priations. After general debate the bill shall be considered  
9 for amendment under the five-minute rule, and the first  
10 amendment printed in part 1 of the report of the Commit-  
11 tee on Rules accompanying this resolution shall be consid-  
12 ered as pending. The reading of the bill for further amend-  
13 ment shall not proceed until after disposition of the  
14 amendments printed in part 1 of the report. Each amend-  
15 ment printed in part 1 of the report may be considered  
16 only in the order printed, may be offered only by a Mem-  
17 ber designated in the report, shall be considered as read,  
18 shall be debatable for ten minutes equally divided and con-  
19 trolled by the proponent and an opponent, shall not be  
20 subject to amendment, and shall not be subject to a de-  
21 mand for division of the question in the House or in the  
22 Committee of the Whole. After disposition of the amend-  
23 ments printed in part 1 of the report, the provisions of  
24 the bill, as amended, shall be considered as the original  
25 bill for the purpose of further amendment under the five-

1 minute rule. Further consideration of the bill for amend-  
2 ment shall proceed by title rather than by paragraph.  
3 Each title shall be considered as read. Points of order  
4 against provisions considered as the original bill for failure  
5 to comply with clause 2 or 6 of rule XXI are waived. It  
6 shall be in order at any time to consider the amendments  
7 printed in part 2 of the report of the Committee on Rules.  
8 Each amendment printed in part 2 of the report may be  
9 offered only by a Member designated in the report, shall  
10 be considered as read, shall be debatable for the time spec-  
11 ified in the report equally divided and controlled by the  
12 proponent and an opponent, shall not be subject to amend-  
13 ment except as specified in the report, and shall not be  
14 subject to a demand for division of the question in the  
15 House or in the Committee of the Whole. All points of  
16 order against amendments printed in the report of the  
17 Committee on Rules are waived. During further consider-  
18 ation of the bill for amendment, the Chairman of the Com-  
19 mittee of the Whole may accord priority in recognition on  
20 the basis of whether the Member offering an amendment  
21 has caused it to be printed in the portion of the Congres-  
22 sional Record designated for that purpose in clause 6 of  
23 rule XXIII. Amendments so printed shall be considered  
24 as read. At the conclusion of consideration of the bill for  
25 amendment the Committee shall rise and report the bill

1 to the House with such amendments as may have been  
2 adopted. The previous question shall be considered as or-  
3 dered on the bill and amendments thereto to final passage  
4 without intervening motion except one motion to recommit  
5 with or without instructions.
