Mr. LINDER, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 1594) to place restrictions on the promotion by the Department of Labor and other Federal agencies and instrumentalities of economically targeted investments in connection with employee benefit plans.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of
3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 1594) to place restrictions on the

1 promotion by the Department of Labor and other Federal
2 agencies and instrumentalities of economically targeted in-
3 vestments in connection with employee benefit plans. The
4 first reading of the bill shall be dispensed with. General
5 debate shall be confined to the bill and shall not exceed
6 two hours equally divided and controlled by the chairman
7 and ranking minority member of the Committee on Eco-
8 nomic and Educational Opportunities. After general de-
9 bate the bill shall be considered for amendment under the
10 five-minute rule. It shall be in order to consider as an
11 original bill for the purpose of amendment under the five-
12 minute rule the amendment in the nature of a substitute
13 recommended by the Committee on Economic and Edu-
14 cational Opportunities now printed in the bill. Each sec-
15 tion of the committee amendment in the nature of a sub-
16 stitute shall be considered as read. At the conclusion of
17 consideration of the bill for amendment the Committee
18 shall rise and report the bill to the House with such
19 amendments as may have been adopted. Any Member may
20 demand a separate vote in the House on any amendment
21 adopted in the Committee of the Whole to the bill or to
22 the committee amendment in the nature of a substitute.
23 The previous question shall be considered as ordered on
24 the bill and amendments thereto to final passage without

- 1 intervening motion except one motion to recommit with
- 2 or without instructions.
