Mrs. WALDHOLTZ, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 743) to amend the National Labor Relations Act to allow labor management cooperative efforts that improve economic competitiveness in the United States to continue to thrive, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of
3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-

1 ation of the bill (H.R. 743) to amend the National Labor
2 Relations Act to allow labor management cooperative ef-
3 forts that improve economic competitiveness in the United
4 States to continue to thrive, and for other purposes. The
5 first reading of the bill shall dispensed with. Points of
6 order against consideration of the bill for failure to comply
7 with clause 2(l)(2)(B) of rule XI are waived. General de-
8 bate shall be confined to the bill and shall not exceed one
9 hour equally divided and controlled by the chairman and
10 ranking minority member of the Committee on Economic
11 and Educational Opportunities. After general debate the
12 bill shall be considered for amendment under the five-
13 minute rule. It shall be in order to consider as an original
14 bill for the purpose of amendment under the five-minute
15 rule the amendment in the nature of a substitute rec-
16 ommended by the Committee on Economic and Edu-
17 cational Opportunities now printed in the bill. Each sec-
18 tion of the committee amendment in the nature of a sub-
19 stitute shall be considered as read. During consideration
20 of the bill for amendment, the Chairman of the Committee
21 of the Whole may accord priority in recognition on the
22 basis of whether the Member offering an amendment has
23 caused it to be printed in the portion of the Congressional
24 Record designated for that purpose in clause 6 of rule
25 XXIII. Amendments so printed shall be considered as

1 read. At the conclusion of consideration of the bill for
2 amendment the Committee shall rise and report the bill
3 to the House with such amendments as may have been
4 adopted. Any Member may demand a separate vote in the
5 House on any amendment adopted in the Committee of
6 the Whole to the bill or to the committee amendment in
7 the nature of a substitute. The previous question shall be
8 considered as ordered on the bill and amendments thereto
9 to final passage without intervening motion except one
10 motion to recommit with or without instructions.
