Mr. KLUG submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the
Committee on House Oversight

RESOLUTION

Requiring that travel awards from official travel of a Member, officer, or employee of the House of Representatives be used only for official travel.

1 *Resolved,*

2 **SECTION 1. LIMITATION ON USE OF TRAVEL AWARDS.**

3 Notwithstanding any provision of law or any rule,
4 regulation, or other authority, any travel award that ac-
5 crues by reason of official travel of a Member, officer, or
6 employee of the House of Representatives may be used
7 only with respect to official travel.

1 **SEC. 2. REGULATIONS.**

2 The Committee on House Oversight of the House of
3 Representatives shall have authority to prescribe regula-
4 tions to carry out this resolution.

5 **SEC. 3. DEFINITIONS.**

6 As used in this resolution—

7 (1) the term “travel award” means any fre-
8 quent flier mileage, free travel, discounted travel, or
9 other travel benefit, whether awarded by coupon,
10 membership, or otherwise;

11 (2) the term “official travel” means, with re-
12 spect to the House of Representatives, travel per-
13 formed for the conduct of official business of the
14 House of Representatives, including official and rep-
15 resentational duties of a Member relating to the dis-
16 trict of the Member; and

17 (3) the term “Member of the House of Rep-
18 resentatives” means a Representative in, or a Dele-
19 gate or Resident Commissioner to, the Congress.
