7 tion shall be considered as read and shall be debatable
8 for one hour equally divided and controlled by the pro-
9 ponent and an opponent. All points of order against that
10 motion are waived. The previous question shall be consid-
11 ered as ordered on that motion to final adoption without
12 intervening motion or demand for division of the question.
