1 the Senate amendment numbered 115 thereto, and to con-
2 sider in the House the motion printed in section 2 of this
3 resolution. The Senate amendment and the motion shall
4 be considered as read. All points of order against the mo-
5 tion are waived. The motion shall be debatable for one
6 hour equally divided and controlled by the proponent and
7 an opponent. The previous question shall be considered as
8 ordered on that motion to final adoption without interven-
9 ing motion or demand for division of the question.

10 SEC. 2. The motion of dispose of the amendment of
11 the Senate numbered 115 is as follows:

12 Mr. Callahan (or his designee) moves that the House
13 recede from its amendment to the amendment of the Sen-
14 ate numbered 115, and concur therein with an amendment
15 as follows:

16 In lieu of the matter proposed by said amendment,
17 insert:

18 “Authorization of Population planning

19 “SEC. 518A. Section 526 of this Act shall not apply
20 to funds made available in this Act for population plan-
21 ning activities or other population assistance pursuant to
22 section 104(b) of the Foreign Assistance Act or any other
23 provision of law, or to funds made available in the title
24 IV of this Act as a contribution of the United Nations
25 Population Fund (UNFPA).”.
