Mr. BARR of Georgia submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Rules

RESOLUTION

Providing for the consideration of the bill (H.R. 125) to repeal the ban on semiautomatic assault weapons and the ban on large capacity ammunition.

1 *Resolved*, That immediately upon the adoption of this
2 resolution it shall be in order, any rule of the House to
3 the contrary notwithstanding, to consider in the House the
4 bill (H.R. 125) to repeal the ban on semiautomatic assault
5 weapons and the ban on large capacity ammunition feed-
6 ing devices, and for other purposes. The first reading of
7 the bill shall be dispensed with. General debate shall be
8 confined to the bill and shall not exceed one and one half
9 hours controlled by Representative Barr of Georgia or his
10 designee. The previous question shall be considered as or-

- 1 dered on the bill and amendments thereto to final passage
- 2 without intervening motion except one motion to recom-
- 3 mit.
