RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 3021) to guarantee the continuing full investment of Social Security and other Federal funds in obligations of the United States.

1 *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution
2 it shall be in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R.
3 3021) to guarantee the continuing full investment of So-
4 cial Security and other Federal funds in obligations of the
5 United States. The amendment printed in the report of
6 the Committee on Rules accompanying this resolution

1 shall be considered as adopted. The bill, as amended, shall
2 be debatable for one hour equally divided and controlled
3 by the chairman and ranking minority member of the
4 Committee on Ways and Means. The previous question
5 shall be considered as ordered on the bill, as amended,
6 to final passage without intervening motion except one
7 motion to recommit. The motion to recommit may include
8 instructions only if offered by the minority leader or his
9 designee.
