Mr. QUILLEN, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

---

## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 842) to provide off-budget treatment for the Highway Trust Fund, the Airport and Airway Trust Fund, the Inland Waterways Trust Fund, and the Harbor Maintenance Trust Fund.

1       *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this  
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of  
3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee  
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-  
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 842) to provide off-budget treat-

1 ment for the Highway Trust Fund, the Airport and Air-  
2 way Trust Fund, the Inland Waterways Trust Fund, and  
3 the Harbor Maintenance Trust Fund. The first reading  
4 of the bill shall be dispensed with. General debate shall  
5 be confined to the bill and shall not exceed two hours  
6 equally divided among and controlled by the chairman and  
7 ranking minority members of the Committee on Transpor-  
8 tation and Infrastructure and the Committee on the Budg-  
9 et. After general debate the bill shall be considered for  
10 amendment under the five-minute rule. It shall be in order  
11 to consider as an original bill for the purpose of amend-  
12 ment under the five-minute rule the amendment in the na-  
13 ture of a substitute recommended by the Committee on  
14 Transportation and Infrastructure now printed in the bill.  
15 Each section of the committee amendment in the nature  
16 of a substitute shall be considered as read. During consid-  
17 eration of the bill for amendment, the Chairman of the  
18 Committee of the Whole may accord priority in recognition  
19 on the basis of whether the Member offering an amend-  
20 ment has caused it to be printed in the portion of the Con-  
21 gressional Record designated for that purpose in clause  
22 6 of rule XXIII. Amendments so printed shall be consid-  
23 ered as read. At the conclusion of consideration of the bill  
24 for amendment the Committee shall rise and report the  
25 bill to the House with such amendments as may have been

1 adopted. Any Member may demand a separate vote in the  
2 House on any amendment adopted in the Committee of  
3 the Whole to the bill or to the committee amendment in  
4 the nature of a substitute. The previous question shall be  
5 considered as ordered on the bill and amendments thereto  
6 to final passage without intervening motion except one  
7 motion to recommit with or without instructions.
