Mr. GOSS, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

---

RESOLUTION

Providing for the consideration of the bill (H.R. 1675) to amend the National Wildlife Refuge System Administration Act of 1966 to improve the management of the National Wildlife Refuge System, and for other purposes.

1       *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this  
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of  
3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee  
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-  
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 1675) to amend the National Wild-  
6 life Refuge System Administration Act of 1966 to improve

1 the management of the National Wildlife Refuge System,  
2 and for other purposes. The first reading of the bill shall  
3 be dispensed with. General debate shall be confined to the  
4 bill and shall not exceed one hour equally divided and con-  
5 trolled by the chairman and ranking minority member of  
6 the Committee on Resources. After general debate the bill  
7 shall be considered for amendment under the five-minute  
8 rule. In lieu of the amendment recommended by the Com-  
9 mittee on Resources now printed in the bill, it shall be  
10 in order to consider as an original bill for the purpose of  
11 amendment under the five-minute rule the amendment in  
12 the nature of a substitute printed in the Congressional  
13 Record on April 16, 1996 and numbered 1 pursuant to  
14 clause 6 of rule XXIII. Each section of that amendment  
15 in the nature of a substitute shall be considered as read.  
16 Points of order against that amendment in the nature of  
17 a substitute for failure to comply with clause 7 of rule  
18 XVI are waived. During consideration of the bill for  
19 amendment, the Chairman of the Committee of the Whole  
20 may accord priority in recognition on the basis of whether  
21 the Member offering an amendment has caused it to be  
22 printed in the portion of the Congressional Record des-  
23 ignated for that purpose in clause 6 of rule XXIII. Amend-  
24 ments so printed shall be considered as read. At the con-  
25 clusion of consideration of the bill for amendment the

1 Committee shall rise and report the bill to the House with  
2 such amendments as may have been adopted. Any Member  
3 may demand a separate vote in the House on any amend-  
4 ment adopted in the Committee of the Whole to the bill  
5 or to the amendment in the nature of a substitute made  
6 in order as original text. The previous question shall be  
7 considered as ordered on the bill and amendments thereto  
8 to final passage without intervening motion except one  
9 motion to recommit with or without instructions.
