Ms. PRYCE, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2641) to amend title 28, United States Code, to provide for appointment of United States marshals by the Director of the United States Marshals Service.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of
3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 2641) to amend title 28, United
6 States Code, to provide for appointment of United States

1 marshals by the Director of the United States Marshals
2 Service. The first reading of the bill shall be dispensed
3 with. General debate shall be confined to the bill and shall
4 not exceed one hour equally divided and controlled by the
5 chairman and ranking minority member of the Committee
6 on the Judiciary. After general debate the bill shall be con-
7 sidered for amendment under the five-minute rule. It shall
8 be in order to consider as an original bill for the purpose
9 of amendment under the five-minute rule the amendment
10 in the nature of a substitute recommended by the Commit-
11 tee on the Judiciary now printed in the bill. Each section
12 of the committee amendment in the nature of a substitute
13 shall be considered as read. During consideration of the
14 bill for amendment, the Chairman of the Committee of
15 the Whole may accord priority in recognition on the basis
16 of whether the Member offering an amendment has caused
17 it to be printed in the portion of the Congressional Record
18 designated for that purpose in clause 6 of rule XXIII.
19 Amendments so printed shall be considered as read. At
20 the conclusion of consideration of the bill for amendment
21 the Committee shall rise and report the bill to the House
22 with such amendments as may have been adopted. Any
23 Member may demand a separate vote in the House on any
24 amendment adopted in the Committee of the Whole to the
25 bill or to the committee amendment in the nature of a

1 substitute. The previous question shall be considered as
2 ordered on the bill and amendments thereto to final pas-
3 sage without intervening motion except one motion to re-
4 commit with or without instructions.

5 SEC. 2. After passage of H.R. 2641, it shall be in
6 order to take from the Speaker's table the bill S. 1338
7 and to consider the Senate bill in the House. It shall be
8 in order to move to strike all after the enacting clause
9 of the Senate bill and to insert in lieu thereof the provi-
10 sions of H.R. 2641 as passed by the House. If the motion
11 is adopted and the Senate bill, as amended, is passed, then
12 it shall be in order to move that the House insist on its
13 amendments to S. 1338 and request a conference with the
14 Senate thereon.
