Mr. GOSS, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for further consideration of the bill (H.R. 3734) to provide for reconciliation pursuant to section 201(a)(1) of the concurrent resolution on the budget for fiscal year 1997.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of
3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for further
5 consideration of the bill (H.R. 3734) to provide for rec-
6 onciliation pursuant to section 201(a)(1) of the concurrent

1 resolution on the budget for fiscal year 1997. All time for
2 general debate under the terms of the order of the House
3 of July 17, 1996, shall be considered as expired. Further
4 general debate shall be confined to the bill and amend-
5 ments specified in this resolution and shall not exceed two
6 hours equally divided and controlled by the chairman and
7 ranking minority member of the Committee on the Budg-
8 et. After general debate the bill shall be considered for
9 amendment under the five-minute rule. An amendment in
10 the nature of a substitute consisting of the text of H.R.
11 3829, modified by the amendment printed in part 1 of
12 the report of the Committee on Rules accompanying this
13 resolution, shall be considered as adopted in the House
14 and in the Committee of the Whole. The bill, as amended,
15 shall be considered as the original bill for the purpose of
16 further amendment and shall be considered as read. No
17 other amendment shall be in order except (1) the further
18 amendment printed in part 2 of the report of the Commit-
19 tee on Rules, which may be offered only by the chairman
20 of the Committee on the Budget or his designee, shall be
21 considered as read, shall be debatable for the time speci-
22 fied in the report equally divided and controlled by the
23 proponent and an opponent, shall not be subject to amend-
24 ment, and shall not be subject to a demand for division
25 of the question in the House or in the Committee of the

1 Whole; and (2) a further amendment in the nature of a
2 substitute consisting of the text of H.R. 3832, which may
3 be offered only by the minority leader or his designee, shall
4 be considered as read, shall be debatable for one hour
5 equally divided and controlled by the proponent and an
6 opponent, and shall not be subject to amendment. All
7 points of order against the further amendments are
8 waived. At the conclusion of consideration of the bill, as
9 amended, for amendment the Committee shall rise and re-
10 port the bill, as amended, to the House with such further
11 amendments as may have been adopted. The previous
12 question shall be considered as ordered on the bill, as
13 amended, and any further amendments thereto to final
14 passage without intervening motion except one motion to
15 recommit with or without instructions.
