Mr. QUILLEN, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 3816) making appropriations for energy and water development for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1997, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of
3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 3816) making appropriations for
6 energy and water development for the fiscal year ending

1 September 30, 1997, and for other purposes. The first
2 reading of the bill shall be dispensed with. General debate
3 shall be confined to the bill and shall not exceed one hour
4 equally divided and controlled by the chairman and rank-
5 ing minority member of the Committee on Appropriations.
6 After general debate the bill shall be considered for
7 amendment under the five-minute rule. Points of order
8 against provisions in the bill for failure to comply with
9 clause 2 or 6 of rule XXI are waived. During consideration
10 of the bill for amendment, the Chairman of the Committee
11 of the Whole may accord priority in recognition on the
12 basis of whether the Member offering an amendment has
13 caused it to be printed in the portion of the Congressional
14 Record designated for that purpose in clause 6 of rule
15 XXIII. Amendments so printed shall be considered as
16 read. The Chairman of the Committee of the Whole may
17 postpone until a time during further consideration in the
18 Committee of the Whole a request for a recorded vote on
19 any amendment. The Chairman of the Committee of the
20 Whole may reduce to not less than five minutes the time
21 for voting by electronic device on any postponed question
22 that immediately follows another vote by electronic device
23 without intervening business, provided that the time for
24 voting by electronic device on the first in any series of
25 questions shall be not less than fifteen minutes. After the

1 reading of the final lines of the bill, a motion that the
2 Committee of the Whole rise and report the bill to the
3 House with such amendments as may have been adopted
4 shall, if offered by the majority leader or a designee, have
5 precedence over a motion to amend. At the conclusion of
6 consideration of the bill for amendment the Committee
7 shall rise and report the bill to the House with such
8 amendments as may have been adopted. The previous
9 question shall be considered as ordered on the bill and
10 amendments thereto to final passage without intervening
11 motion except one motion to recommit with or without in-
12 structions.
