RESOLUTION

Approving certain regulations to implement provisions of the Congressional Accountability Act of 1995 relating to labor-management relations with respect to employing offices and covered employees of the House of Representatives, and for other purposes.

2 **SECTION 1. APPROVAL OF REGULATIONS.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—The regulations described in sub-
4 section (b) are hereby approved, insofar as such regula-
5 tions apply to employing offices and covered employees of
6 the House of Representatives under the Congressional Ac-

1 countability Act of 1995 and to the extent such regula-
2 tions are consistent with the provisions of such Act.

3 (b) REGULATIONS APPROVED.—The regulations re-
4 ferred to in subsection (a) are the regulations issued by
5 the Office of Compliance on July 9, 1996, under section
6 220(d) of the Congressional Accountability Act of 1995
7 to implement section 220 of such Act (relating to the ap-
8 plication of chapter 71 of title 5, United States Code),
9 as published in the Congressional Record on July 11, 1996
10 (Volume 142, daily edition), beginning on page H7454.

11 **SEC. 2. ADOPTION OF REGULATIONS RELATING TO HEAR-**
12 **ING OFFICERS.**

13 The Board of Directors of the Office of Compliance
14 shall adopt regulations (in accordance with section 304 of
15 the Congressional Accountability Act of 1995) to imple-
16 ment the requirement that the Board refer any matter
17 under section 220(e)(1) of such Act which relates to em-
18 ploying offices and covered employees of the House of
19 Representatives to a hearing officer.
