Mr. SIMPSON (for himself and Mr. BAUCUS) introduced the following bill;
which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Finance

A BILL

To terminate the application of title IV of the Trade Act
of 1974 to Bulgaria.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. TERMINATION OF APPLICATION OF TITLE IV**
4 **OF THE TRADE ACT OF 1974 TO BULGARIA.**

5 (a) **PRESIDENTIAL DETERMINATIONS AND EXTEN-**
6 **SION OF NONDISCRIMINATORY TREATMENT.**—Notwith-
7 standing any provision of title IV of the Trade Act of 1974
8 (19 U.S.C. 2431 et seq.), the President may—

9 (1) determine that such title should no longer
10 apply to the Republic of Bulgaria; and

1 (2) after making a determination under para-
2 graph (1), proclaim the extension of nondiscrim-
3 inatory treatment (most-favored-nation treatment)
4 to the products of Bulgaria.

5 (b) TERMINATION OF APPLICATION OF TITLE IV.—
6 On and after the effective date of the extension under sub-
7 section (a)(2) of nondiscriminatory treatment to the prod-
8 ucts of Bulgaria, title IV of the Trade Act of 1974 shall
9 cease to apply to that country.
