Mr. WARNER (for himself and Mr. ROBB) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources

A BILL

To authorize the Secretary of the Interior to acquire and to convey certain lands or interests in lands to improve the management, protection, and administration of Colonial National Historical Park, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CONVEYANCE.**

4 The Secretary of the Interior (referred to in this Act
5 as the “Secretary”) is authorized to grant within the coun-
6 ty of York, Virginia, perpetual easements, or a fee simple
7 interest in land, including any improvements or struc-

1 tures, to the county of York, Virginia, without reimburse-
2 ment, charge, or fee, subject to such conditions as are de-
3 termined by the Secretary to be necessary for the protec-
4 tion of Federal interests, for rights-of-way through, over,
5 or under the lands of Colonial National Historical Park,
6 now or hereafter acquired, for the purposes of operating
7 a sewage disposal system.

8 **SEC. 2. INCLUSION OF LAND IN COLONIAL NATIONAL HIS-**
9 **TORICAL PARK.**

10 Notwithstanding the provisions of the Act of June 28,
11 1938 (52 Stat. 1208; 16 U.S.C. 81b et seq.), limiting the
12 average width of the Colonial Parkway, the Secretary of
13 the Interior is authorized to include within the boundaries
14 of Colonial National Historical Park and acquire by dona-
15 tion, exchange, or purchase with donated or appropriated
16 funds—

17 (1) the lands or interests in lands described as
18 lots 30 to 48, inclusive;

19 (2) the portion of lot 49 that is 200 feet in
20 width from the existing boundary of Colonial Na-
21 tional Historical Park;

22 (3) a 3.2-acre archaeological site, as shown on
23 the plats titled “Page Landing At Jamestown being
24 a subdivision of property of Neck O Land Limited
25 Partnership” dated June 21, 1989, sheets 2 and 3

1 of 3 sheets and bearing National Park Service
2 Drawing Number 333.80031; and

3 (4) all or a portion of the adjoining lot number
4 11 of the Neck O Land Hundred Subdivision, with
5 or without improvements.

6 **SEC. 3. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

7 There are authorized to be appropriated such sums
8 as are necessary to carry out this Act.
