3 **SECTION 1. EXCLUSION OF PRIVATE LANDS FROM SEG-**
4 **MENT OF MISSOURI RIVER DESIGNATED AS A**
5 **RECREATIONAL RIVER.**

6 Section 3(a) of the Wild and Scenic Rivers Act (16
7 U.S.C. 1274(a)) is amended in the undesignated para-
8 graph relating to the Missouri River, Nebraska and South

1 Dakota, by inserting before the period at the end the fol-
2 lowing: “, except that the boundary on the South Dakota
3 segment of the river shall not include any private lands”.
