A BILL

To amend the Stewart B. McKinney Homeless Assistance Act to reauthorize programs relating to homeless assistance for veterans.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. JOB PLACEMENT FOR HOMELESS VETERANS.**

4 (a) HOMELESS VETERAN EMPLOYMENT PROGRAM.—
5 Section 738(e)(1) of the Stewart B. McKinney Homeless
6 Assistance Act (42 U.S.C. 11448(e)(1)) is amended by
7 striking out subparagraphs (A), (B), and (C) and insert-
8 ing in lieu thereof the following new subparagraphs:

9 “(A) \$10,000,000 for fiscal year 1996.

10 “(B) \$10,000,000 for fiscal year 1997.

1 “(C) \$10,000,000 for fiscal year 1998.”.

2 (b) GENERAL AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIA-
3 TIONS.—Section 739(a) of such Act (42 U.S.C. 11449(a))
4 is amended by striking out “fiscal years 1994 and 1995”
5 and inserting in lieu thereof “fiscal years 1996, 1997, and
6 1998”.

7 (c) EXTENSION OF PROGRAM.—Section 741 of such
8 Act (42 U.S.C. 11450) is amended by striking out “Octo-
9 ber 1, 1995” and inserting in lieu thereof “October 1,
10 1998”.

11 (d) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
12 this section shall take effect on October 1, 1995.
