A BILL

To reauthorize the tied aid credit program of the Export-Import Bank of the United States, and to allow the Export-Import Bank to conduct a demonstration project.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF TIED AID CREDIT PROGRAM.**

4 (a) TIED AID CREDIT FUND.—Section 10(c)(2) of  
5 the Export-Import Bank Act of 1945 (12 U.S.C. 635i-

1 3(c)(2)) is amended by striking “the September 30,  
2 1995” and inserting “September 30, 1997”.

3 (b) AUTHORIZATION.—Section 10(e) of the Export-  
4 Import Bank Act of 1945 (12 U.S.C. 635i–3(e)) is amend-  
5 ed by striking “1993, 1994, and 1995” and inserting  
6 “1996 and 1997”.

7 **SEC. 2. AUTHORITY TO CONDUCT A DEMONSTRATION**  
8 **PROJECT.**

9 Notwithstanding section 4701(a)(1)(A) of title 5,  
10 United States Code, the Export-Import Bank of the Unit-  
11 ed States may conduct a demonstration project in accord-  
12 ance with section 4703 of such title.
