Mr. MOYNIHAN (for himself and Mr. INOUE) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Governmental Affairs

## A BILL

To require a separate, unclassified statement of the aggregate amount of budget outlays for intelligence activities.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Aggregate Intelligence  
5 Budget Disclosure Act of 1995”.

6 **SEC. 2. PURPOSE.**

7 It is the purpose of this Act to require the publication  
8 of the aggregate intelligence budget figure to provide a  
9 more thorough accounting of Government expenditures as

1 required by article I, section 9, clause 7 of the Constitu-  
2 tion.

3 **SEC. 3. FINDINGS.**

4 The Congress finds that—

5 (1) article I, section 9, clause 7 of the Constitu-  
6 tion states that “No Money shall be drawn from the  
7 Treasury, but in Consequence of Appropriations  
8 made by Law; and a regular Statement and Account  
9 of the Receipts and Expenditures of all public  
10 Money shall be published from time to time.”;

11 (2) during the Cold War the United States did  
12 not provide to the American people a “regular State-  
13 ment and Account of the . . . Expenditures” for  
14 intelligence activities; and

15 (3) the failure to provide to the American peo-  
16 ple a statement of the total amount of expenditures  
17 on intelligence activities prevents them from partici-  
18 pating in an informed, democratic decision concern-  
19 ing the appropriate level for such expenditures.

20 **SEC. 4. ANNUAL STATEMENT OF THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF**  
21 **INTELLIGENCE EXPENDITURES FOR THE**  
22 **PRECEDING FISCAL YEAR.**

23 Section 1105(a) of title 31, United States Code, is  
24 amended by adding at the end thereof the following new  
25 paragraph:

1           “(33) a separate, unclassified statement of the  
2           total amount of budget outlays for the preceding fis-  
3           cal year for national and tactical intelligence activi-  
4           ties, including activities carried out under the budget  
5           of the Department of Defense to collect, analyze,  
6           produce, disseminate, or support the collection of  
7           intelligence.”.
