A BILL

To extend the Middle East Peace Facilitation Act.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That—

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 583(a) of the Foreign Re-
5 lations Authorization Act, Fiscal Years 1994 and 1995
6 (Public Law 103–236), as amended, is amended by strik-
7 ing “November 1, 1995” and inserting “December 1,
8 1995”.

9 (b) CONSULTATION.—For purposes of any exercise of
10 the authority provided in section 583(a) of the Foreign
11 Relations Authorization Act, Fiscal Years 1994 and 1995
12 (Public Law 103–236) prior to November 15, 1995, the

1 written policy justification dated June 1, 1995, and sub-
2 mitted to the Congress in accordance with section
3 583(b)(1) of such Act, and the consultations associated
4 with such policy justification, shall be deemed to satisfy
5 the requirements of section 583(b)(1) of such Act.
