A BILL

To provide that no State or local government shall be obligated to take any action required by Federal law enacted after the date of the enactment of this Act unless the expenses of such government in taking such action are funded by the United States.

1 **SECTION 1. SUFFICIENT FEDERAL FUNDING REQUIRE-**
2 **MENT FOR ANY FEDERAL LAW WHICH OBLI-**
3 **GATES ANY STATE OR LOCAL GOVERNMENT**
4 **TO TAKE ANY ACTION REQUIRING ANY EX-**
5 **PENDITURE OF STATE OR LOCAL FUNDS.**

6 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, no State
7 or local government shall be obligated to take any action
8 required by Federal law enacted after the date of the en-
9 actment of this Act unless the expenses of such govern-
10 ment in taking such action are funded by the United
11 States.
