Mr. HELMS (for himself, Mr. DODD, and Mr. KERRY) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Foreign Relations

## A BILL

To extend au pair programs.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF AU PAIR PROGRAMS.**

4 (a) REPEAL.—Section 8 of the Eisenhower Exchange  
5 Fellowship Act of 1990 (Public Law 101–454) is repealed.

6 (b) AUTHORITY FOR AU PAIR PROGRAMS.—The Di-  
7 rector of the United States Information Agency is author-  
8 ized to continue to administer an au pair program, operat-  
9 ing on a world-wide basis, through fiscal year 1999.

10 (c) REPORT.—Not later than October 1, 1998, the  
11 Director of the United States Information Agency shall  
12 submit a report regarding the continued extension of au

1 pair programs to the Committee on Foreign Relations of  
2 the Senate and the Committee on International Relations  
3 of the House of Representatives. This report shall specifi-  
4 cally detail the compliance of all au pair organizations  
5 with regulations governing au pair programs as published  
6 on February 15, 1995.
