A BILL

To provide new authority for probation and pretrial services
officers, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. NEW AUTHORITY FOR PROBATION AND PRE-**

4 **TRIAL SERVICES OFFICERS.**

5 (a) PROBATION OFFICERS.—Section 3603 of title 18,
6 United States Code, is amended—

7 (1) by striking “and” at the end of paragraph
8 (8)(B);

9 (2) by redesignating paragraph (9) as para-
10 graph (10); and

1 (3) by inserting after paragraph (8) the follow-
2 ing new paragraph:

3 “(9) if approved by the district court, be au-
4 thorized to carry firearms under such rules and reg-
5 ulations as the Director of the Administrative Office
6 of the United States Courts may prescribe; and”.

7 (b) PRETRIAL SERVICES OFFICERS.—Section 3154
8 of title 18, United States Code, is amended—

9 (1) by redesignating paragraph (13) as para-
10 graph (14); and

11 (2) by inserting after paragraph (12) the fol-
12 lowing new paragraph:

13 “(13) As approved by the district court, carry
14 firearms under such rules and regulations as the Di-
15 rector of the Administrative Office of the United
16 States Courts may prescribe.”.
