Mr. GRASSLEY (for himself and Mr. HEFLIN) introduced the following bill;
which was read twice and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

To make technical corrections to title 11, United States Code, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Bankruptcy Technical
5 Corrections Act of 1996”.

6 **SEC. 2. DEFINITIONS.**

7 Section 101 of title 11, United States Code, is
8 amended—

9 (1) by striking “In this title—” and inserting
10 “In this title:”;

1 (2) in paragraph (51B)—

2 (A) by inserting “family farms and” after
3 “other than”; and

4 (B) by striking all after “thereto” and in-
5 serting a semicolon;

6 (3) by reordering the paragraphs so that the
7 terms defined in the section are in alphabetical order
8 and redesignating the paragraphs accordingly;

9 (4) in paragraph (37)(B), as redesignated, by
10 striking “paragraphs (21B) and (33)(A)” and in-
11 serting “paragraphs (23) and (35)(A)”;

12 (5) in each paragraph, by inserting a heading,
13 the text of which is comprised of the term defined
14 in the paragraph;

15 (6) by inserting “The term” after each para-
16 graph heading; and

17 (7) by striking the semicolon at the end of each
18 paragraph and “; and” at the end of paragraphs
19 (35) and (38) and inserting a period.

20 **SEC. 3. ADJUSTMENT OF DOLLAR AMOUNTS.**

21 Section 104 of title 11, United States Code, is
22 amended by inserting “522(f)(3),” after “522(d),” each
23 place it appears.

1 **SEC. 4. COMPENSATION TO OFFICERS.**

2 Section 330(a) of title 11, United States Code, is
3 amended—

4 (1) in paragraph (1), by inserting “, or the
5 debtor’s attorney” after “1103”;

6 (2) in paragraph (3), by striking “(3)(A) In”
7 and inserting “(3) In”; and

8 (3) in paragraph (4)(A)(ii)(I), by striking “or”
9 and inserting “and”.

10 **SEC. 5. EFFECT OF CONVERSION.**

11 Section 348(f)(2) of title 11, United States Code, is
12 amended by inserting “of the estate” after “property” the
13 first place it appears.

14 **SEC. 6. ALLOWANCE OF ADMINISTRATIVE EXPENSES.**

15 Section 503(b)(4) of title 11, United States Code, is
16 amended by inserting “subparagraph (A), (B), (C), (D),
17 or (E) of” after “under”.

18 **SEC. 7. PRIORITIES.**

19 Section 507(a)(7) of title 11, United States Code, is
20 amended by inserting “unsecured” after “allowed”.

21 **SEC. 8. EXEMPTIONS.**

22 Section 522 of title 11, United States Code, is
23 amended—

24 (1) in subsections (b)(1) and (d)(10)(E), by
25 striking “unless” and inserting “but only to the ex-
26 tent that”; and

1 **SEC. 13. LIABILITY OF TRANSFEREE OF AVOIDED TRANS-**
2 **FER.**

3 Section 550(c)(1) of title 11, United States Code, is
4 amended by striking “547(b)” and inserting “547”.

5 **SEC. 14. GENERAL PROVISIONS.**

6 Section 901(a) of title 11, United States Code, is
7 amended by inserting “1123(d),” after “1123(b),”.

8 **SEC. 15. DISCHARGE.**

9 Section 1228 of title 11, United States Code, is
10 amended by striking “1222(b)(10)” each place it appears
11 and inserting “1222(b)(9)”.

12 **SEC. 16. CONTENTS OF PLAN.**

13 Section 1322 of title 11, United States Code, is
14 amended—

15 (1) in subsection (b), by striking “(c)” and in-
16 serting “(d)”; and

17 (2) in subsection (e), by striking the comma
18 after “default” the second place it appears.

19 **SEC. 17. DISCHARGE.**

20 Section 1328(a) of title 11, United States Code, is
21 amended—

22 (1) in paragraph (1), by adding “or” after the
23 semicolon;

24 (2) in paragraph (2), by striking “or 523(a)(9)
25 of this title; or” and inserting a period; and

1 (3) in paragraph (3), by inserting “, or a fine
2 to the extent such fine exceeds \$500,” after “restitu-
3 tion”.

4 **SEC. 18. BANKRUPTCY REVIEW COMMISSION.**

5 Section 604 of the Bankruptcy Reform Act of 1994
6 (108 Stat. 4147) is amended—

7 (1) by striking subsection (g); and

8 (2) by redesignating subsection (h) as sub-
9 section (g).

10 **SEC. 19. EFFECTIVE DATE OF AMENDMENTS.**

11 The amendments made by this Act shall apply in all
12 cases or proceedings filed or commenced on or after March
13 22, 1996.
