Mr. BREAUX introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

For the relief of Tarek Elagamy.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENCE.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other provi-
5 sion of law, for purposes of the Immigration and National-
6 ity Act (8 U.S.C. 1101 et seq.), Tarek Elagamy shall be
7 held and considered to have been lawfully admitted to the
8 United States for permanent residence as of the date of
9 the enactment of this Act upon payment of the required
10 visa fee.

11 (b) REDUCTION OF NUMBER OF AVAILABLE
12 VISAS.—Upon the granting of permanent residence to

1 Tarek Elagamy as provided in this Act, the Secretary of
2 State shall instruct the proper officer to reduce by one
3 number during the current fiscal year the total number
4 of immigrant visas available to natives of the country of
5 the alien's birth under section 203(a) of the Immigration
6 and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1153(a)).
