Mr. GRAMM (for himself and Ms. MOSELEY-BRAUN) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Finance

A BILL

To correct the marking requirements for American-made feather and down-filled products.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. MARKING OF CERTAIN AMERICAN-MADE TEX-**

4 **TILE PRODUCTS.**

5 Section 304 of the Tariff Act of 1930 (19 U.S.C.
6 1304) is amended by redesignating subsections (f), (g),
7 and (h) as subsections (g), (h), and (i), respectively, and
8 inserting before subsection (g), as redesignated, the fol-
9 lowing new subsection:

1 “(f) MARKING OF CERTAIN AMERICAN-MADE TEX-
2 TILE PRODUCTS.—An exception under subsection (a)(3)
3 of this title shall apply for textile products classified under
4 HTS subheading 9404.90: *Provided*, That such products
5 are manufactured in the United States and that such
6 manufacturing effects a change to subheading 9404.90
7 from any other heading: *Provided further*, That such prod-
8 ucts are filled with feathers and/or down: *Provided further*,
9 That such product shells are of cotton fabric, no less than
10 85 per centum by weight of cotton.”.

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
