## A BILL

To amend the Developmental Disabilities Assistance and Bill of Rights Act to extend the Act, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Developmental Disabil-  
5 ities Assistance and Bill of Rights Act Amendments of  
6 1996”.

7 **SEC. 2. REAUTHORIZATION OF ALLOTMENTS FOR STATES.**

8 Section 130 of the Developmental Disabilities Assist-  
9 ance and Bill of Rights Act (42 U.S.C. 6030) is amended

1 by striking “the fiscal years 1995 and 1996” and inserting  
2 “the fiscal years 1995 through 1999”.

3 **SEC. 3. REAUTHORIZATION OF AUTHORITIES RELATING TO**  
4 **PROTECTION AND ADVOCACY OF INDIVIDUAL**  
5 **RIGHTS.**

6 Section 143 of the Developmental Disabilities Assist-  
7 ance and Bill of Rights Act (42 U.S.C. 6043) is amended  
8 by striking “the fiscal years 1995 and 1996” and inserting  
9 “the fiscal years 1995 through 1999”.

10 **SEC. 4. REAUTHORIZATION OF AUTHORITIES RELATING TO**  
11 **UNIVERSITY AFFILIATED PROGRAMS.**

12 Section 156(a) of the Developmental Disabilities As-  
13 sistance and Bill of Rights Act (42 U.S.C. 6066(a)) is  
14 amended by striking “the fiscal years 1995 and 1996” and  
15 inserting “the fiscal years 1995 through 1999”.

16 **SEC. 5. REAUTHORIZATION OF AUTHORITIES RELATING TO**  
17 **PROJECTS OF NATIONAL SIGNIFICANCE.**

18 Section 163(a) of the Developmental Disabilities As-  
19 sistance and Bill of Rights Act (42 U.S.C. 6083(a)) is  
20 amended by striking “the fiscal years 1995 and 1996” and  
21 inserting “the fiscal years 1995 through 1999”.
