## A BILL

To amend the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States to provide for duty free treatment for certain semi-manufactured forms of gold.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ELIMINATION OF DUTY ON CERTAIN SEMI-MAN-**  
4 **UFACTURED FORMS OF GOLD.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subheading 7108.13.50 of the  
6 Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is  
7 amended to read as follows:

| | | | IL, J, MX) | | ”.

1       (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by  
2 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or  
3 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after  
4 the 15th day after the date of the enactment of this Act.
