Mr. MURKOWSKI introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources

A BILL

Entitled “Aleutian World War II National Historic Areas Act of 1996”.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Aleutian World War
5 II National Historic Areas Act of 1996”.

6 **SEC. 2. PURPOSE.**

7 The purpose of this Act is to designate and preserve
8 the Aleutian World War II National Historic Area within
9 lands owned by the Ounalaska Corporation on the island
10 of Amaknak, Alaska and to provide for the interpretation,
11 for the educational and inspirational benefit of present

1 and future generations, of the unique and significant cir-
2 cumstances involving the history of the Aleut people, and
3 the role of the Aleut people and the Aleutian Islands in
4 the defense of the United States in World War II.

5 **SEC. 3. BOUNDARIES.**

6 The Aleutian World War II National Historic Area
7 shall be comprised of areas on Amaknak island depicted
8 on the map entitled “Aleutian World War II National His-
9 toric Area”.

10 **SEC. 4. TERMS AND CONDITIONS.**

11 Nothing in this Act shall—

12 (1) authorize the conveyance of lands between
13 the Ounalaska Corporation and the United States
14 Department of the Interior, nor remove land or
15 structures appurtenant to the land from the exclu-
16 sive control of the Ounalaska Corporation; or

17 (2) provide authority for the Department of the
18 Interior to assume the duties associated with the
19 daily operation of the Historic Area or any of its fa-
20 cilities or structures.

21 **SEC. 5. TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE.**

22 The Secretary of the Interior may award grants and
23 provide technical assistance to the Ounalaska Corporation
24 and the city of Unalaska to assist with the planning, devel-
25 opment, and historic preservation from any program funds

- 1 authorized by law for technical assistance, land use plan-
- 2 ning or historic preservation.
