To authorize a certificate of documentation for certain vessels, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CERTIFICATES OF DOCUMENTATION.**

4 Notwithstanding section 27 of the Merchant Marine
5 Act, 1920 (46 U.S.C. App. 883), section 8 of the Act of
6 June 19, 1886 (24 Stat. 81, chapter 421; 46 U.S.C. App.
7 289), and sections 12106 through 12108 of title 46, Unit-
8 ed States Code, the Secretary of Transportation may issue
9 a certificate of documentation with appropriate endorse-

1 ment for employment in the coastwise trade for each of
2 the following vessels:

3 (1) The vessel RELENTLESS, United States
4 official number 287008.

5 (2) The vessel TECUMSEH, United States of-
6 ficial number 668633.

7 (3) The vessel POLICY MAKER III, United
8 States official number 569223.

9 (4) The vessel QUIET SQUAW, United States
10 official number 998717.
