Mr. WARNER (for himself and Mr. FORD) introduced the following bill; which was read twice, considered, read a third time, and passed

A BILL

To authorize the Capital Guide Service to accept voluntary services.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That section 441 of the Legislative Reorganization Act of
4 1970 (40 U.S.C. 851) is amended by striking subsection
5 (j) and inserting the following:

6 “(j)(1) Notwithstanding section 1342 of title 31,
7 United States Code, the Capitol Guide Service is author-
8 ized to accept voluntary personal services.

9 “(2) No person shall be permitted to donate personal
10 services under this subsection unless the person has first
11 agreed, in writing, to waive any claim against the United

1 States arising out of or in connection with such services,
2 other than a claim under chapter 81 of title 5, United
3 States Code.

4 “(3) No person donating personal services under this
5 section shall be considered an employee of the United
6 States for any purpose other than for purposes of chapter
7 81 of title 5, United States Code.

8 “(4) In no case shall the acceptance of personal serv-
9 ices under this section result in the reduction of pay or
10 displacement of any employee of the Capitol Guide
11 Service.”.
